## **Notice of a Special General Meeting (SGM)**

- WHEN?** Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> October, 1pm
- WHERE?** 80 Fitzgerald Avenue, Christchurch
- WHY?** This SGM has been requested by some members

1. "The proposed wooden floor has become a very contentious issue with our members hence the request for an SGM, some of the concerns of the members are as follows, but are not limited to the list below:
  - a. The wooden floor will be cold especially during the winter months and will require heating to make it cosy which in turn will be costly given the price of power.

2. "Election of Officers":
